CHICAGO: TWO WORLD’S FAIRS, 40 YEARS APART

The World’s Columbian Exposition in 1893 and A Century of Progress Exposition in 1934 were both hosted in Chicago. Intended to mark the 400th anniversary of Columbus’s arrival in the New World, the World’s Columbian Exposition was a monumental event that featured neoclassical architecture, the first electric lighting and innovations like the Ferris wheel and moving walkway.

A Century of Progress was the second World’s Fair held in Chicago and a showcase for modern living, consumerism and entertainment. All of this was designed to stimulate spending during the Great Depression. There were nearly two dozen corporate pavilions pushing the latest gadgets for homes and cars. This World’s Fair introduced millions of people to the newly created lakefront and foretold the rising influence that the automobile would have on city life.



Each World’s Fair had a lasting impact on the city’s architecture, economy, culture and identity. Both served as a powerful declaration of Chicago’s resilience and forward-thinking spirit after a period of devastation caused by the Great Fire of 1871 and the Great Depression.
